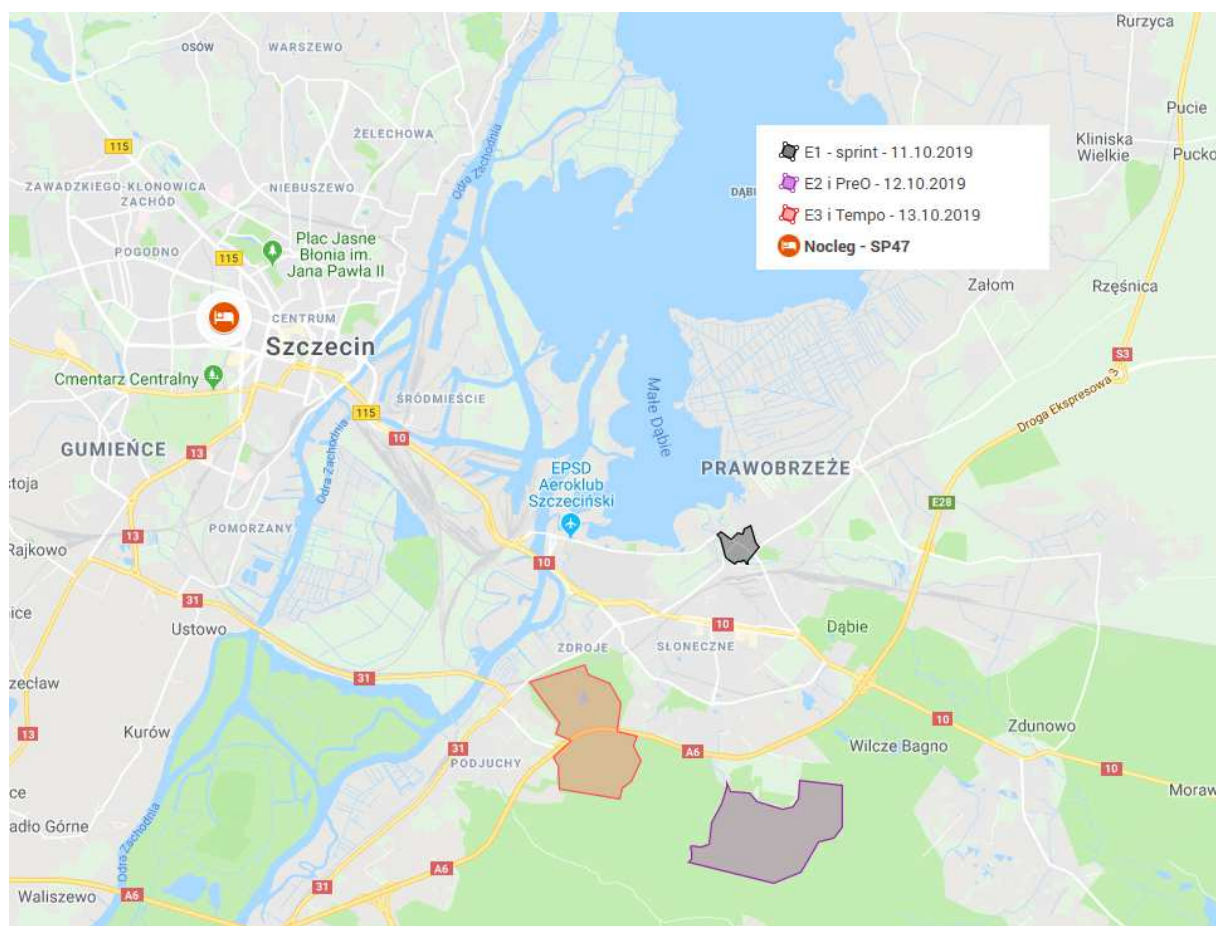

PARTICIPATION

According to the PZOS regulations, competitors participating in CTZ competitions who want to participate in the sport competition organized by PZOS (competition for ranking points) must have a valid PZOS license. Lack of license, however, does not exclude players from sports competition during the Bukowa Cup, the competition is open for everyone. Competitors who want to compete for ranking points within the WRE in Trail-0 must have an account on the EVENTOR platform and have an IOF ID number. By creating an account on the Eventor, each competitor receives his number from the machine.

All are required to have valid medical examinations. People competing in the Bukowa Cup competitions who do not have valid medical certificate are obliged to show their start-up statements at their own responsibility.

Athletes entered in Para categories must have a medical certificate in accordance with IOF ([Appendix 12b of the License Regulations](#))

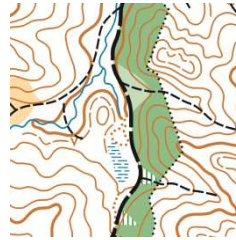
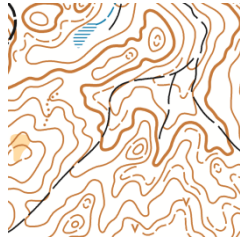
Shortened long:

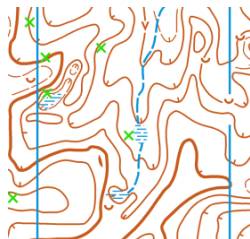
Day 3:

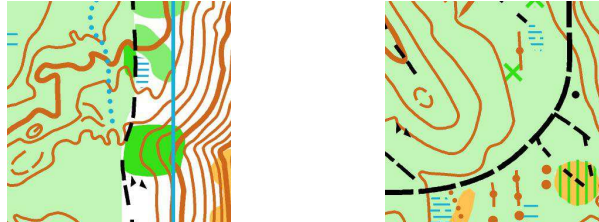

OPEN CATEGORIES:

SHORT - easy, short, for beginners without age restrictions

AVERAGE - harder, longer, for intermediate people without age limits,

LONG - technically difficult and technically demanding, with no age limits

FAMILY - very easy and short, for families with small children

Pre0 and Tempo

OPEN ELITE - covers all competitors regardless of sex, age and degree of disability

PARA ELITE - includes athletes of all ages and sexes, whose disability significantly
limits their movement capabilities in accordance with Appendix No. 12b of the PZOS
License Regulations

YOUNG ELITE - it includes players up to 14 years old (born in 2005) regardless of gender

A - CLASS - covers all competitors regardless of gender, age and disability level and
does not want to compete for WRE points

TIMING SYSTEM

The Bukowa Cup competition will be played using the SportIdent electronic confirmation system. It is possible to borrow a SI chip from the Organizer. This should be indicated in the application.

During the competition the contactless SportIdent AIR + control point system will be used.

The Pre0 and Tempo0 events will be played using the Sport Ident system, the players will confirm the points with chips. Near the decision points there will be carousels with Sport Ident stations.

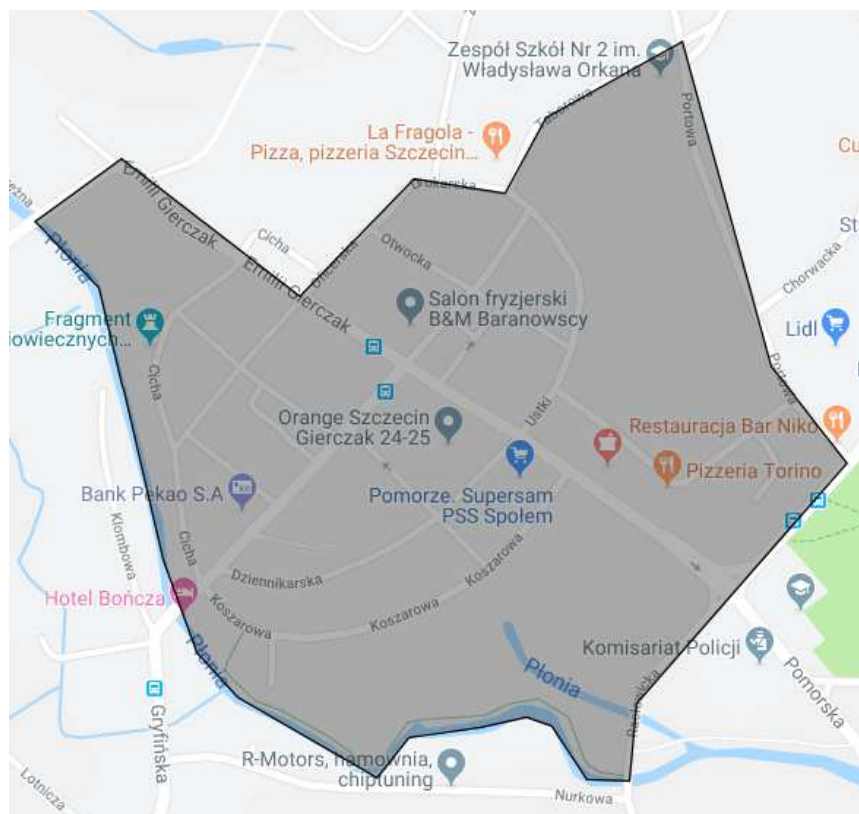

CLOSED AREA

The organizer closes the area in which competition Bukowa Cup 6 will be held on the following conditions:

Sprint - E1

In a closed area it is allowed to stop as a resident, student, for business or tourism purposes (eg sightseeing, visiting a restaurant, shopping, participating in indoor sports events). In a closed area it is prohibited to: stay with a map for Sport Orientation, running, or orienteering.
